Convoyer's Report: The birds arrived on site at 3.30pm on Friday 30th May. They were given time to settle and then fed & watered. The water was topped up later. Convoyers rose at 5am Saturday 31st May and water was replenished. Weather was fine but very misty. There was no prospect of liberation until the mist had cleared and the original plan of liberation at 7am was extremely doubtful. At 7.10am weather was poor at the site. Complete overcast, cold and mist. It was expected to clear but liberation unlikely before at least 9am. At 8.30am weather was improving but no liberation was possible. The weather eventually cleared and at 11am the sun appeared. The strings were cut and after consultation with the race advisor the birds were liberated at 11.15am into a light NE wind. They cleared the site immediately towards the north.
