**Convoyer's Report:** Arrived at Cherbourg at about 12.45pm on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June – gave the birds water before driving to Messac where we arrived at 4.30pm. Birds were fed and watered. Water replenished in the evening before turning in. Rose at 4am and checked on water for the birds, re-filling drinkers where necessary. We had planned on a liberation by as early as 5am but, although the sun was shining it was very hazy. Spoke with the race advisor and other convoyers on site and it was agreed to liberate at 6.30am when the haze had gone. Birds cleared well into a light northerly wind which was expected to increase from the NE en route. Whilst driving back to the port, it was very hot and we ran through a small amount of rain near to Avranches. The wind was a strong NE at Cherbourg. I understand it has been a hard race and hope all your birds work back.
