**Convoyer's Report:** The birds arrived on site at Nort-sur-Erdre at 5.15pm BST on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> June and were fed and watered. 5.45am Saturday. There was complete overcast and rain at the racepoint and en route. No prospect of liberation at this time. 8.35am Decision taken in consultation with race advisor that there will be no liberation today. The weather through France is bad. 4.45pm Saturday. The birds had now been fed and watered. It had been raining all day at the racepoint.

5am Sunday. The birds were watered. The weather was fine and sunny with a light west wind. Following consultation with the race advisor and other convoyers at the site and throughout France, the birds were liberated at 7.30am in a light west wind and cleared well. The weather was fine, sunny and clear en route back to Cherbourg with a small amount of rain in just one area – nothing which should have affected the birds. Thank you to all for their assistance at pick-ups – there is still one club putting sawdust in the crates – I would ask that they stop doing this and use coarse dry sand.
