Convoyer's Report: Firstly can I thank everyone for the assistance given at the pick-up points especially at Thornbury where in excess of 2000 birds were loaded. We arrived at the docks in Plymouth at 2.30am and made sure there was water before the birds. We kept water in the drinkers when boarding the ferry for the 8am sailing and on arrival at Roscoff again ensured there was water in the drinkers for the 200 mile journey to Carentan. We arrived on site at 7pm and after settling the birds fed and watered them before turning in for sleep at 10.30pm. We rose at 6am and topped up water. Weather was overcast with a NW wind but the overcast was expected to clear by 10am. I consulted with the race advisor. By 9.30am there were large patches of blue sky and sunshine. Visibility was very good. At 9.50am we liberated and all but about 70 pigeons cleared the site immediately. The stragglers cleared after a few minutes. The Wiltshire Fed liberated I believe at 10.15am and the Dorset Fed at 10.30am. All liberations were good. I hope you had a good race though I expect it would have been fairly tough in the NW wind.
