Convoyer's Report: Firstly thank you to the members at Radstock for assisting in transferring all crates top one transporter. We arrived on site at 1.30am and made sure water was before the birds before turning in for sleep. Rose at 5am and topped up the water. The weather was overcast with occasional bouts of drizzle. Visibility was generally good and there was a light west wind. We consulted with the race advisor who expected the overcast and occasional rain to clear most of the Combine area later in the morning. At 8.30am following further consultation it was decided that the birds should be liberated as soon as conditions at the liberation site were good enough with sunshine being visible. The liberation took place at 10.25am into a light west wind with sun breaking through. The birds cleared the site within 2-3 minutes.
