### Convoyer's Report: Will be forwarded later

### Martin Pike Chief Convoyer

**Secretary's Note:** I have been unable to speak with Martin today – from my initial brief chat with him on Saturday morning I can only confirm that following arrival on site at about 1.30am the birds were watered. This was topped up at 5am. The initial plan was to liberate at 6am provided weather was suitable. Following consultation with the race advisor it was decided to delay liberation in order for the air to get warmer. It was a fine morning with a WNW wind. It was later agreed to liberate at 7am which was done following the setting off of a rocket to deter BoP (I was not aware of the use of rockets until today, Sunday). Most birds cleared well with about 100 or so being left circling the site. More details will be forwarded after I have spoken with Martin. In view of the amount of Welsh pigeons found in various parts of the Combine, together with our birds, it is believed that the Combine birds clashed with the Welsh who were liberated at Blandford at 7.30am. Our race advisor had been in constant contact with the Welsh controller who was aware both before our liberation and immediately afterwards that we were going at 7am.
