**Convoyer's Report:** Arrived on site at 1.30am and placed water before the birds. Rose at 5am and topped up water. It was still dark but there was low cloud and it was quite chilly. Wind was a light WNW. Liaised with the race advisor at 6am and arranged to speak again at 7am as the weather was expected to improve. By 7am there were white clouds with blue sky and sunshine. It was quite warm – we were in T-shirts. We agreed to liberate at 7.15am which we did. The birds immediately split into two large groups and cleared the site well except for a smaller group which were delayed leaving the vehicle due to the flaps sticking on about 6 crates. I have since learnt there have been reports of the birds hanging about the site – this was not true, in fact I would say it was one of the best liberations we have had. Please check that all of your crates have lids which do not stick. I later spoke with the convoyer for the Kent Cosmopolitan who asked when we liberating. I told him we had gone at 7.15 and he said that they had liberated at Bedhampton at 7.30am which I thought was not too clever as there was a big danger of clashing.
