Convoyer's Report: Arrived at Portsmouth docks at 1.30am on Thursday 22nd June and put water before the birds before turning in. Boarded the ferry at 7.30am and made sure all drinkers were full for the crossing. Came off ferry in Caen at 3pm (UK time) and waited for half an hour to check water in the drinkers. Arrived at Messac at 6.30pm (UK) where we replenished water. Birds fed at 7pm. When opening up the rear corridor door to water and feed two birds flew out. They had escaped from insecure crate(s). Informed the combine Secretary. (We later discovered that a dowel had broken off of a crate which then only contained six birds). We believe this was caused at loading by someone pulling on the dowel instead of the wooden frame of the crate. Rose at 5.30am (UK) on 23rd June and topped up water. Set off for Saintes at 6.30am. Weather was fine and pleasantly warm – not hot. Arrived on site at 1pm (UK) and watered birds. Fed and watered with electrolytes at 3.30pm (UK). Left shutters half open during the night. We had planned on an early liberation. Rose at 5am (UK) and topped up water. Weather was fine with clear blue sky and no wind. Liberated at 6am (UK) – the birds split into two groups and cleared within 1-2 minutes. Weather was fine and sunny throughout our journey back to Caen.
