**Convoyer's Report:** (To be circulated later)

**Secretary's Note:** I have been unable to contact the convoyer so his report will be delayed. This week's race has proved difficult for many. It was our decision that we must do everything possible to avoid clashing with other organisations. Those coming west to east are a particular danger to the whole of the combine as are those travelling north from the coast. Clubs further north in the Combine are also at risk from liberations in Somerset and from the Welsh birds (wherever they may be – we don't always know). It was felt that by delaying our liberation until 1pm all these other organisations would be clear. Weather was generally fine all day so this didn't affect the decision. It has been reported to us from independent sources that the liberation was fine, the birds splitting into three groups and clearing the site very quickly. They were not seen to return. Also reported that a 'gale force' west wind was blowing over Salisbury Plain although general weather was fine.
