**Convoyers Report:** After a smooth sailing we arrived at Fougeres liberation site at 16.45. We parked up opened the sides of the truck and watered the birds. We fed the birds at 17.30pm and let them be until 21.30, until the light started to fade, we topped up the water and closed the lorry up for the night. We got up at 7am Saturday morning checked on the birds and topped up the water but did not open the sides of the lorry due to a lot of mist and low temperature. We opened the sides of the lorry at 8.15 once it had warmed up a little and waited for the weather to clear.

We eventually liberated at 10.15 into a very light north wind with blue skies and a few white fluffy clouds. The birds left the transporter very quickly and immediately headed in the direction of England without circling or hesitation.
